### Team Categories & Quiz Material: (all locations)

1. Book 1: 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Coed: Start Zone + Disc. 1 – 4
2. Book 2: 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Coed: Disc. 1 – 4
3. Book 3: 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Coed: Chal. 1 – 4
4. Book 4: 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Coed: Chal. 1 – 4

### Registration:

### Quiz Questions and Answers: T&T

1. Teams consist of up to **4** members for T&T. Because participants are scored individually during Multiple Choice each Team must have a **minimum of 2 or more Quizzers**. Churches may enter more than one Team if they have 5 or more Quizzers in a category.
2. All questions will be taken from the material in the latest edition of the AWANA handbooks, manuals and materials. Participants are not expected to interpret the materials.
3. Questions may be asked on any part of the material assigned, including verses, Bible readings, definitions, books of the Bible, etc. (sections, Discoveries, Challenges, lessons).
4. The Quizmaster prefaces each question with the word "Question." No talking is allowed from the word "Question" until the answer is given.
5. Should the Quizmaster read a question improperly, the question may be discarded and a new one selected.

6. Scores from all segments are added together to determine the winner. In the event of a tie, an additional Multiple Choice round will be played by the Teams tied until the tie is broken. Once the tie is broken there will be no additional questions.
7. Scoring Summary:

### **Individual Multiple-Choice Quizzing: T&T**

1. Multiple Choice Round will consist of **10 questions** per Team category.
2. Up to **2** Quizzers from each Team may be on the platform at one time. Substitutions can be made **after 5 questions**. Quizzers will be asked a series of Multiple Choice questions. Each Quizzer uses a paddle box to display their answer.
3. Questions and possible answers will be read once (questions may be read twice if the Quizmaster feels the difficulty of the question warrants it). There will be three answers from which to choose. Quizzers have **5 seconds** to determine their choice of answers.
4. During the reading of the questions and selection of answers, Quizzers must look down at their paddles. Looking any other place may result in a disqualification from that question: "Eyes". Quizzers should not touch the paddle they believe to be correct until the "**Paddles up**" call is given.
5. When all possible answers have been given, the Quizmaster will say, "**Select your answer.**" When the five seconds are up, he will call, "Paddles Up."
6. During the five second answer time, individuals select the answer they believe is correct. Then, at the call "**Paddles up,**" all participants will raise their answer simultaneously.
7. After the "Paddles up" call has been made, no paddle may be exchanged for another paddle.
8. If a participant's paddle is raised late, the participant is disqualified from that question.
9. Participants will keep their paddles raised until the command "**Paddles down**" is given to give scorekeepers time to score the Quizzers answer.
10. If the Quizzer(s) on a single chair successfully answer all **10** questions their Team is awarded an **extra 15 bonus points**.
11. If a single Quizzer successfully answers all 10 questions, that Quizzer has "**Quizzed Out**" and is awarded a special ribbon.

### **Team Written or Huddle Quizzing: T&T**

1. Team Huddle Round will consist of **10 questions or 15 minutes**, whichever comes first, per Team category.
2. Up to **4** Quizzers from each Team may be on the platform at one time. Substitutions can be made  $\frac{1}{2}$  way thru the Round (after 5 Questions).
3. Teams will sit on chairs **facing each** other in a circle. Each Team will have a **white board, dry erase marker and eraser**.
4. In this segment, a series of questions will be asked. Each question will be read twice. One or more of the following styles may be used in the Written Quiz: completion, matching, multiple-choice, finish the verse, and true or false.
5. The Team is allowed approximately **30 seconds** to confer quietly and come up with one answer. This answer is then written on the white board (within the 30 seconds). When the answer is recorded, the writer **should raise the marker** above his/her head to indicate that the Team is ready.
6. At the end of 30 seconds (or when all markers are raised), the Quizmaster will call **"Boards Up"** and the Quizzers will display their answers to the audience.
7. If there is concern about the correctness of an answer, Judges will decide whether the answer is valid. Only a blank slate or everything marked out is a **"non-answer."**
8. Questions asked (other than Scripture quotations) may be answered in the participant's own words, but must be close to what the handbook/manual states. The Judges determine whether anything important to the meaning has been left out or altered.
9. If the Team successfully answers all **10** questions their Team is awarded an **extra 30 bonus points**.
